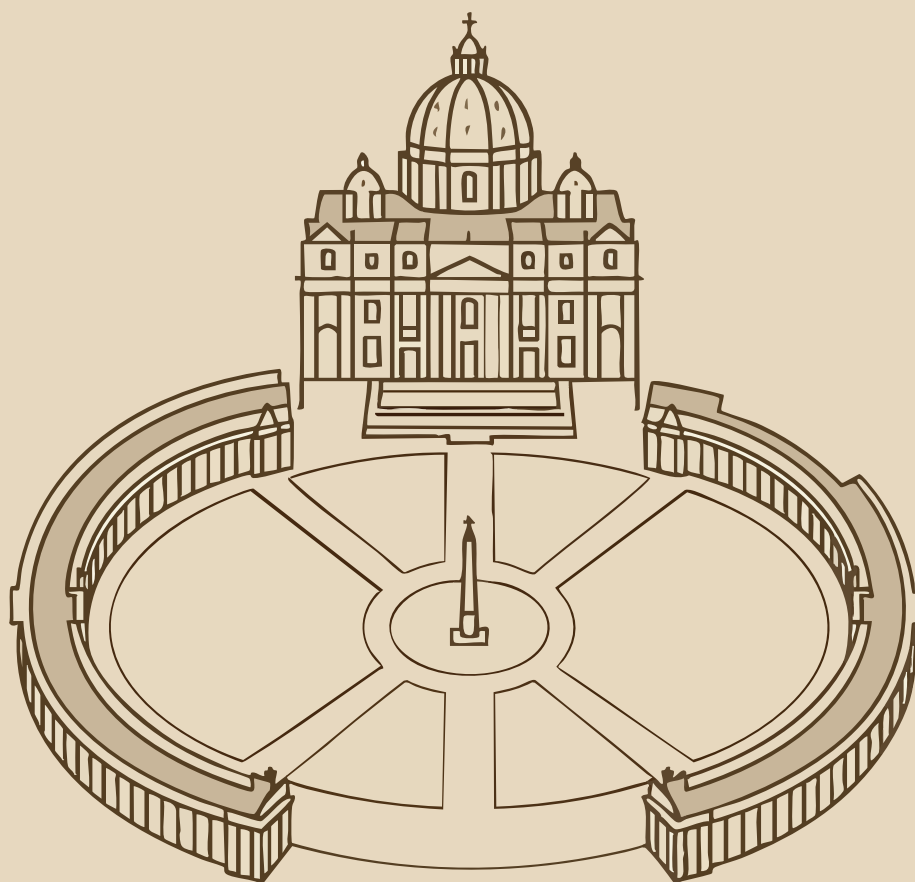




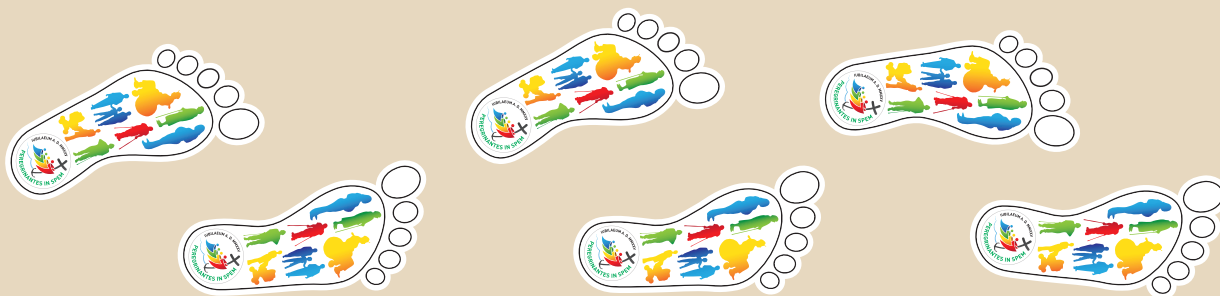

## **EASY TO READ PATH** **PIAZZA PIA - HOLY DOOR OF ST. PETER**



Welcome,

This guide has been made to help you experience the 2025 Jubilee.

The Jubilee is a Holy Year celebrated every 25 years.

During the Jubilee, the Pope opens the Holy Door of the main churches in Rome.

The most important door is the one at St. Peter's Basilica.



Pilgrims are people who pray while walking towards the Holy Door.

This guide is for pilgrims who want to pass through the Holy Door.

The path to the Holy Door goes along Via della Conciliazione,  
the large street that connects Castel Sant'Angelo to St. Peter's Basilica.



The main route to the Holy Door starts from Piazza Pia.

The path is marked with stickers on the ground.

These stickers are foot-shaped and coloured green and white.

Follow the foot-shaped stickers to reach the Holy Door.



To make a pilgrimage to the Holy Door, you must register.  
To register, send an email to find out the available date and time.  
If you want to book the pilgrimage, write to: [accoglienza@fsp.va](mailto:accoglienza@fsp.va).

For the pilgrimage, we recommend wearing:

- Comfortable shoes
- Comfortable clothing
- An umbrella (useful for rain or sun)

If you bring water bottles or flasks, you must leave them before entering St. Peter's Square.  
You can retrieve your bottle or flask after exiting the square.

To enter St. Peter's Square, security checks are required.

You must:

- Pass through a metal detector
- Have your bag or backpack inspected



Security personnel are available to help you if needed.

If you need assistance during the pilgrimage, ask the people wearing a green uniform with the word Volunteer.

## Route 1 - from Piazza Pia

Piazza Pia is a new square in Rome.



In the centre of the square, there are two large round fountains.



On one side of the square, you can look out and see the Tiber River.



On the other side, there is an info point with many windows and some steps to enter. The info point is a place where you can ask for information.





Next to the info point, there is a water dispenser.  
You can fill your bottle or flask with water.



The path to the Holy Door begins from Piazza Pia.  
The Holy Door is located in St. Peter's Basilica.  
St. Peter's Basilica is at the end of Via della Conciliazione.  
Via della Conciliazione is the wide straight road that starts from Piazza Pia.



Along the path to the Holy Door, follow the foot-shaped stickers on the ground.



Along the way, you must cross a road with many cars passing by.  
Be careful and cross only when the traffic light is green for pedestrians.

If you need help, ask the people wearing a green uniform with the word Volunteer.



When you reach the end of Via della Conciliazione, walk under the large columns.  
Under the columns, there are people who need to check the items you are carrying.  
To complete this check, you must:

- Pass through a metal detector
- Have your bag or backpack inspected



The people who do the checks can help you if needed.  
After the checks, follow the path.  
Go up the stairs or take the ramp.



Enter the Basilica by passing under the Holy Door.
